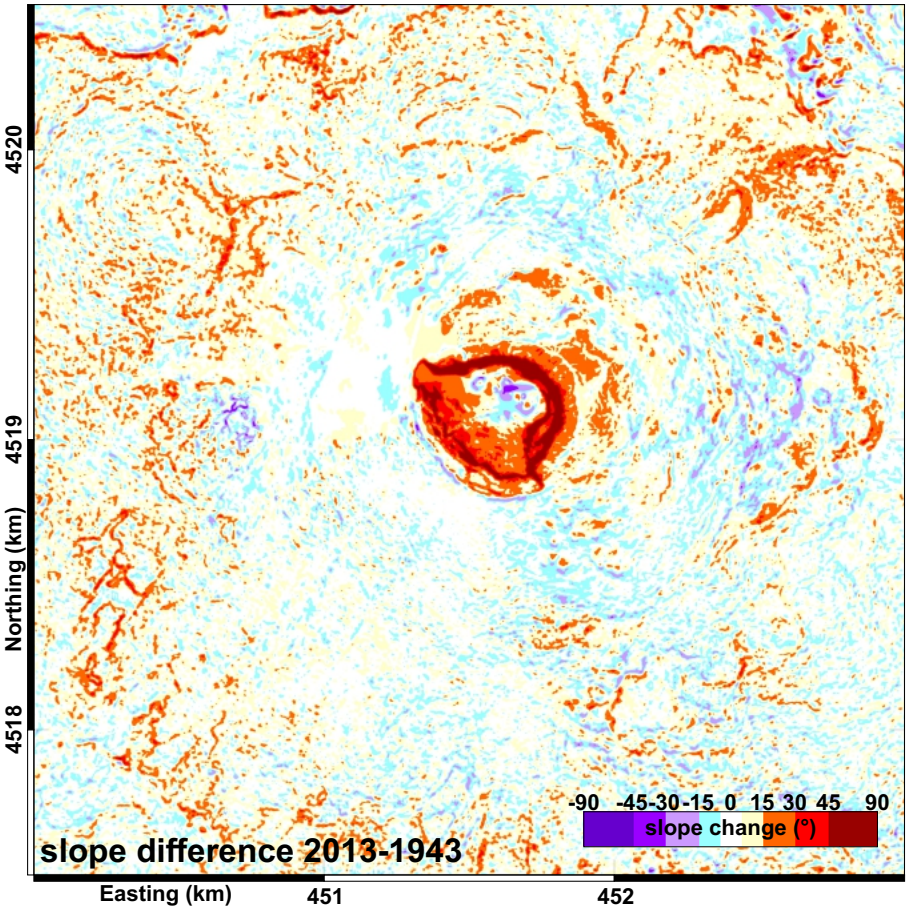


Figure S1: Change in slope at Vesuvius between 1943<sub>CE</sub> and 2013<sub>CE</sub>.

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
